## Popular Courses

#### **Introduction to Therapy**

Students learn about aromatherapy, traditional Chinese medicine, herbal medicine and many other therapy methods. They also learn breathing and stretching techniques, Japanese taiko drumming and other methods to enable them to tailor their therapy to the needs of different people.

#### Basic Nursing B (Preventive and Exercise Study)

Students learn about the lives of people who require nursing care and learn about "independence support" by which nursing care allows patients to gain independence. They will also gain a deeper understanding of applying rehabilitation techniques to help patients move limbs and joints, roll over in bed and get up out of bed and also preventive body exercises to help keep patients from needing nursing care in the first place.
